

11.1 Flying Start Risk Assessments- Hazardous substances (This states what the risks are and what to do if they have contact with eyes or skin or are ingested)

All staff following guidance from management taken from COSHH (The control of substances hazardous to health regulations)

- Reading and understanding the safety sheets on all products.
- Ensuring staff have adequate training, instruction and information

<p>■ Identification of a risk: Where is it and what is it?</p>	<p>Who is at risk: Childcare staff, children, parents, cleaners etc?</p>	<p>Level of risk : high, medium, low. (likelihood and impact)</p>	<p>Control measures to reduce/eliminate risk: What will you need to do, or ensure others will do, in order to reduce that risk?</p>	<p>Monitoring and review: How do you know if what you have said is working, or is thorough enough? If it is not working, it will need to be amended, or maybe there is a better solution.</p>
<p>Antibacterial surface cleaner-sprayed on children's/ staff skin/ eyes</p>	<p>Children and staff</p>	<p>low</p>	<p>Keep in high up cupboard out of reach of children. Staff spray when children are not near-use gloves. Let it dry before children are allowed to use tables. If chn of staff get it on skin- wash immediately with cold water. If in eyes wash out eyes immediately.</p>	
<p>Milton sterilising liquid for cleaning toys and equipment.</p>	<p>Children and staff.</p>	<p>low</p>	<p>Keep in high up cupboard out of reach of children. Dilute with correct amount of water and wear gloves. Avoid prolonged contact with metal. Avoid contact with eyes, in the event of contact, rinse eyes with warm water. Do not inhale. Do not use in combination with other products as toxic gases may be released (chlorine). Let toys dry before children are allowed</p>

Cif cream for cleaning kitchen and some equipment.	Children and staff.	low	Store in high up cupboard out of children's reach. Use gloves and in ventilated area. Apply to surface using a damp cloth, then simply wipe over and gently rinse away. Avoid contact with eyes and skin, in the event of contact wash with warm water.	
Hand soap and washing up liquid	Children and staff.	low	Rinse off skin well. Use under supervision. Avoid contact with eyes. Rinse immediately if contact occurs.
